The Windsor Charter Township Board of Appeals meeting was called to order by Chairperson Richard Slee at 6:00 p.m.

**Slucter moved and Stauff seconded to elect Richard Slee as Chairperson. Carried 5-0.**

The applicant, Troy Jamieson, from Crandell Bros. Trucking, explained to the board they are seeking a variance to the zoning ordinance for use of berms in place of fencing and reduce the amount of required posting signs. A site plan was supplied to the board showing the use of topsoil and overburden to create eight foot berms around the excavation site. Mr. Jamieson indicated they currently have two locations in Eaton Township they are using berms in place of fencing. He advocated it helps with dust and sound control.

Questions were asked by the board and sufficiently answered by Mr. Jamieson. After a discussion held by the board and all questions and concerns brought to the table, **Slucter moved and Vertalka seconded to grant the request to use berms in place of fencing. Carried 5-0. Slucter moved and Vertalka seconded for Supervisor Braman to visit the site and determine the amount of signage. Carried 5-0.**

With no further business **Vertalka moved and Stauff seconded to adjourn the meeting. Carried 5-0. Adjourned at 6:30 p.m.**
