ORDINANCE NO. 24

At a regular meeting held September 9, 1986, the Windsor Charter Township Board adopted the following ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 24

An ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Windsor Township, Eaton County, enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967, as amended (M.S.A. 18.1287 (17)), being identical to State Administrative Rules filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

WINDSOR CHARTER TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

SECTION I: All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be construed and have the same meaning as those words and phrases defined in Act 303, P.A. 1967, as amended, M.S.A. 18.1287 (8).

SECTION II: Regulation No. 23, Eaton County, R 281.723.2. Grand River canals and channels: slow-no wake speed. On the waters of the canals and channels connected to the Grand River and located within the Grand Pointe Subdivision, Section 2, T3N, R3W, Windsor Township, Eaton County, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow-no wake speed.

SECTION III: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith repealed.

~~SECTION~~ IV: Violations of this ordinance are a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) together with costs and prosecution or imprisonment in the county jail or such other place of detention as the court may prescribe, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or said fine, costs of prosecution, and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION V: This ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, provisions, sentences and clauses are severable. If any part of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional or invalid it is declared the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected hereby.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication in the Lansing State Journal.
